Walt Whitman (1819 – 1892) was an American poet, essayist and journalist. Often called the father of free verse, Whitman is among the most influential and controversial American poets.

"A Noiseless Patient Spider" is a short poem by Walt Whitman, published in an 1891 edition of *Leaves of Grass*. The poems of *Leaves of Grass* are loosely connected and each represents Whitman's celebration of his philosophy of life and humanity. This book is notable for its delight in sensual pleasures during a time when such candid displays were considered immoral.

As he observes the efforts of a spider to spin its web, Whitman comments on the theme of isolation in society and humankind's efforts to find belonging in the universe and to secure an anchor for the soul.
